

U.S. BILL OF RIGHTS

1ST AMENDMENT

Freedom of religion, speech, press, assembly, and right to petition the government (1791)

2ND AMENDMENT

Right to keep and bear arms (1791)

3RD AMENDMENT

Protection from quartering soldiers (1791)

4TH AMENDMENT

Protection from unreasonable search and arrest (1791)

5TH AMENDMENT

Criminal case rights including grand jury, double jeopardy, self-incrimination, due process (1791)

6TH AMENDMENT

Rights of accused in criminal prosecutions; rights to fair jury trial, to confront opposing witnesses and to counsel (1791)

7TH AMENDMENT

Civil case rights and fair jury trial (1791)

8TH AMENDMENT

Protections against excessive bail, fines, cruel and unusual punishment (1791)

9TH AMENDMENT

rights retained by the people (1791)

10TH AMENDMENT

rights reserved to states (1791)
